Cache Hikers 2017 Summer Activities

13 May, 2017 Deer Fence Trail The Cache Hikers will host a 5-mile Saturday hike along the Deer Fence Trail from Blacksmith Fork to Providence Canyon with an optional 3-mile extension to Dry Canyon. This easy/moderate warm-up hike (600 feet of elevation) provides great views of the Wellsville Mountains as it passes the Millville Predator Research Facility, springs and rock formations. Car shuttle required. Bring food, water, appropriate clothing and a donation for gas if carpooling.
